Guidelines to the Contributors

- ❖ Manuscripts submitted to the Journal should be original contributions and generally should not be under consideration for any other publication at the same time. However, if the Manuscripts are under consideration by another publication, the author should clearly indicate this at the time of submission.
- ❖ Manuscripts should not exceed 5000 words. The word limit should be inclusive of all the notes, references, tables, annexures and appendices.
- ❖ Manuscripts should be prepared in text format (e.g. MS-Word) following British spelling. PDF versions are not accepted by the journal.
- ❖ The article should include (i) the name(s) of the author(s), (ii) their professional affiliations, (iii) postal address, (iv) contact numbers and email address.
- ❖ All Manuscripts should be accompanied by an abstract (150-200 words) along with keywords (3-6).
- ❖ Contributors are requested to send soft copies (in Times New Roman, 12 font size, 1.5 line spacing, on A4 sized page layout in MS-Word format and not exceeding higher version of MS-Office 2007). Hard copy of the Manuscripts will also be required for processing.
- ❖ Each page of the Manuscript should be properly numbered and position of figures and tables should be clearly indicated in the paper.
- ❖ Graphs and Charts prepared in MS-Office or equivalent format are preferred to any other format like jpeg etc.
- ❖ References should be given in the text in parentheses, with the name of the author, year of publication and page numbers. The Journal will follow the APA format.
- ❖ The main text should contain (i) Title, (ii) Name of the author(s), (iii) Abstract with key-words, (iv) Introduction, (v) Objectives, (vi) Research Methodology, (vii) Body of the paper, (viii) Result and discussion, (ix) References.
- ❖ Manuscripts sent should be complete in all respects, including sources of all tables, graphs, figures and maps (where applicable).
- ❖ All Manuscripts submitted for consideration for publication in the journal would be subjected to the Journal's refereeing system.
- ❖ Only a paper fulfilling all the content requirements of the Journal shall be referred for peer review. Non-formatted papers shall not be considered.
- ❖ The final decision on the acceptance or otherwise of the paper rests with the competent authority depending entirely on its originality, standard and relevance. The final draft may be subjected to editorial amendment to suit the requirements of the publication.
